

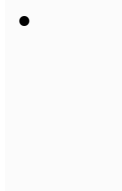

<p>Read and understand the main points in short written texts.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read short texts independently. • Use a translation dictionary or glossary to look up new words. 		<p>Read and understand the main points and some of the detail in short written texts.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use the context of a sentence or a translation dictionary to work out the meaning of unfamiliar words. • Read and understand the main points and opinions in written texts from various contexts, including present, past or future events. • Show confidence in reading aloud, and in using reference materials.

<p>Write or copy everyday words correctly.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Label items and choose appropriate words to complete short sentences. • Write one or two short sentences. • Write short phrases used in everyday conversations correctly. 		<p>Write a few short sentences using familiar expressions.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Express personal experiences and responses. • Write short phrases from memory with spelling that is readily understandable.
