Christianity	It is the world's largest religion, with about 2.5 billion followers
Methodist	Methodists are Christians who follow the teachings of John Wesley and who have their own branch of the Christian church and their own form of worship.
Bible	The Bible is the holy scripture of the Christian religion.
John Wesley	is the founder of Methodism.
Spiritual	relating to or affecting the human spirit or soul as opposed to material or physical things.

John Wesley (1703-1791) is the founder of Methodism.

One night, in 1738, at a spiritual meeting in London, John had an experience that changed his life. He wrote in his journal: "I felt my heart strangely warmed" He believed that he had felt the presence of God for himself.
